<p>The WP4 aimed to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) discuss with policymakers challenges and recommendations how to improve Holocaust education, visibility of places of memory and the cooperation between the mentioned institutions – the objective was reached through the online discussion; 2) disseminate the project and its results among the target groups and broader public – through the local events; 3) increase the visibility of chosen places of memory, and advocate for their victims and survivors – through the online campaign. <p>Considering the activities:</p> <p>1) Discussion with Members of European Parliament on challenges of Dealing with Holocaust in Southern Eastern Europe, online (24 May 2023)</p> <p>The discussion focused on the challenges of Holocaust remembrance, and its connection to European Values of human dignity, freedom, democracy, equality and human rights. The speakers included: Irena Joveva, Member of European Parliament; Predrag Matić, Member of European Parliament; Amedeo Osti Guerrazzi, PhD, University of Padova; Ivo Pejaković, Director of Jasenovac Memorial Site; and Manuel Sarrazin, German Federal Government Special Representative for the Countries of the Western Balkans.</p> <p>2) Local multiplier events</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 17-10-2022. The round table “As stone and bone: architectural heritage and the example of the memorial in Kampor on the island of Rab”, hosted by APIS in the Slovenian national contact point of the program CERV in Koper. The main topic of discussion was the memorial site in the location of the former Italian fascist concentration camp in Rab. To the event took part 32 participants. R1 was presented. • 25-01-2023. The exhibition “Tragom sjećanja/Along the memory trail”, organized by Documenta in Zagreb in occasion of the International Holocaust Remembrance Day. The exhibition collected photos from the concentration camps in Auschwitz and Jasenovac. The coordinators presented the project and the CERV programme. 14 people participated to the opening. 			

- **17-04-2023.** Meeting with representatives of civic society – presentation of Documenta’s work and focus group, organized by Documenta in Zagreb. To the activity took part 13 participants from Belgian civic society. The coordinators presented the project and the CERV programme and discussed future opportunities for cooperation.
- **17-04-2023.** Urban walk “Zagreb during WWII”. Organized by Documenta in Zagreb, with 19 students from the Faculty of Political Science. The coordinators visited lesser known places of memory in Zagreb, focusing on a reflection on challenges of memorialization. They presented the project and opportunities for youth connected with CERV programme.
- **20-06-2023.** Round table “Human rights archiving in the digital age”. The event was coordinated by Documenta in cooperation with the International Network on Human Rights Archives (INHRA), and organized in Zagreb. The coordinators presented the project and the CERV programme, with a focus on digital tools and means how to preserve the memory of WWII via digitalization methods. 8 participants to the event.
- **09-09-2023.** Meeting with the time-witness Slavko Malnar. The event was organized by Documenta on the anniversary of the liberation of the Fascist concentration camp Kampor, on the island of Rab in Croatia. Slavko Malnar, who survived as a children to the violence and deportation, shared his story. 10 participants. His interview is available online and linked to the site of the project through the online campaign.
- **22-09-2023.** Public consultation “The legacy of anti-fascism in contemporary museum and research practices”, organized by Documenta in Pula, Croatia. Aim of the event was to advocate for the inclusion of the topics of anti-fascism and peacemaking in educational programs and for their better representation in contemporary art practices and museum settings. The project and its results were presented as good practice example. 17 direct participants.
- **19-10-2023.** Screening of the documentary “Strah Ostone / The fear remain”, in Cerknica, Slovenia. The event was organized by APIS and Socialna Akademija and involved 16 participants. The partners presented the project and its results, as an introduction to the film, which talks about the legacy of internment in Italian fascist camps.
- **28-10-2023.** Associazione 4704 organized an audio-guided walk in the city of Gorizia, on the topic of the border, which divided Gorizia from Nova Gorica, in the context of WWII and the post-war period. The activity was inspired to one of the methods proposed in R3. To the activity took part 40 participants
- **06-11-2023.** The screening of the documentary “Strah Ostone / The fear remain” was organized by APIS and Socialna Akademija in the Ljubljana city library. After the screening, the partners presented the project and discussed with the researcher Urška Strle about remembrance of Fascist internment camps in Slovenia. 20 people took part in the event.
- **07-11-2023.** Memorial walk in Zagreb. Documenta organized a memorial walk in the city center, for a group of teachers and professionals of the civic sector from Italy. The walk focused on remembrance of WWII and the war of the 1990s in public space of the city of Zagreb. The event included 7 people.
- **14-11-2023.** Associazione 4704 organized again the audio-guided walking tour in Gorizia. The walk, called “My city is orphan”, unites historical research and theater, and is based on the method “headphones participative moving theatre”, presented in the project result “R3”. To the activity took part 48 participants.
- **28-11-2023.** The professor Heike Karge, from the University of Regensburg, organized a lecture in the University of Graz, for the students of the course “Southeast European History and Anthropology”. The lecture titled “Lecture on the politics of memory and marginalized memories regarding the Second World War and the War 1991-1995 in Croatia”. During the lecture, the professor presented the project and its results, with a focus on R2 and R4, and the activities targeted to youth and students. To the activity took part 15 participants.
- **12/13-12-2023.** The partners Max Mannheimer Haus organized a training for youth and memory workers in Dachau, Germany. During the event, the partners presented the project and its results, with a focus on R3. 13 participants took part in the training.
- **19-01-2024.** Documenta organized a guided walk in the city of Zagreb, for the students of the

Faculty of Anthropology. The walk focused on places connected to resistance during Second World War in the city, and followed the methodology of the city rally, presented in R3. 11 students took part in the activity.

3) Online campaign, online (April 2022 – January 2024)

The online campaign followed the project in its entire duration. It consists of 26 posts shared on the web-page of the project ([Between Memory and Oblivion - Kultura sjećanja \(documenta.hr\)](#)), and includes posts on: forgotten places of memory in the partner countries; interviews and life stories of time-witnesses who survived concentration camps and other genocide and forms of violence during WWII; the project results; report from the activities; and other video and audio materials connected to the project's topics.
