



**The project « Meeting Memories: Learning from the Past to Confront Dehumanization Today» was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"**

**Preparatory activities** (if applicable): the activities involved 10 participants.

**Location / Dates:** online, 7-8 November 2020.

**Short description:** these activities consisted of a kick-off (partner preparatory meeting). In the meeting, the partners introduced themselves and their organizations. The consortium discussed project activities, and objectives; communication strategies and visibility; risk management; tasks and obligations.

### **Events:**

6 events have been carried out within this project:

#### **Event 1**

**Participation:** The event involved 98 citizens, including:

4 participants from Bosnia and Herzegovina,  
4 participants from Germany,  
81 participants from Croatia,  
1 participant from Romania,  
2 participants from Slovenia,  
6 participants from Serbia.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in hybrid form, online and in Zagreb, Croatia, from 09/11/2020 to 09/11/2020.

**Short description:** The public conference "*New Approaches to Legacy of Holocaust and Holocaust Education*" 1-day event, on the occasion of the International Day Against Fascism and Anti-Semitism and the 82<sup>nd</sup> anniversary of the Night of Broken Glass. The aim of the event was to start a discussion on the challenges in Holocaust education, the result of years of relativisation and denial of the crimes of Nazis, Fascists and their collaborators in Croatia and elsewhere, as well as on presenting perspectives and examples of good practice from the partner countries. The conference included the following panels: Holocaust Education in the Classroom; Holocaust Education programs of Public Institutions and Civil Society Organizations; New Approaches to Legacy of Holocaust; Media and Legacy of Holocaust.

#### **Event 2**

**Participation:** The event involved 28 citizens, including:

4 citizens from Germany,  
12 citizens from Croatia,  
6 citizens from Italy,  
2 citizens from Slovenia,  
4 citizens from Serbia.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in hybrid form, in Jasenovac, Croatia, and online, from 19/04/2021 to 26/04/2021.

**Short description:** As approved by the Agency, event 2 and 3 were combined, due to the challenges connected to Covid-19. The event 2 included a visit to Jasenovac concentration camp, commemoration, opening of the exhibition „The path of no return”, on the inmates of the camp, and a public discussion in occasion of the opening of the exhibition.

### **Event 3**

**Participation:** The event involved 30 citizens, including:

13 participants from Croatia,  
5 from Italy,  
5 from Slovenia,  
6 from Serbia,  
1 from Austria.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in hybrid form: online, in Belgrade, Serbia, and in the partner countries, from 19/04/2021 to 26/04/2021.

**Short description:** The event was joined with the event 2, in order to reach the same objectives, despite the Covid-19 pandemic. Citizens were involved in a workshop on photography and memory, with the aim to reflect on photography as a tool to deal with memories of WWII. The workshop included online session and in-person visits to national places of remembrance, including Jasenovac memorial, in Croatia, and Staro Sajmište, in Serbia, as well as other memorial places, museums, and former concentration camp sites in the partner countries. On the 26th of April, the partner organized the public online discussion “Photography and memory: new approaches to culture of remembrance”, to discuss the experience of the participants from the workshop with the public.

### **Event 4**

**Participation:** The event involved 31 citizens, including:

4 from Germany,  
1 from Greece,  
9 from Croatia,  
9 from Italy,  
3 from Slovenia,  
5 from Serbia.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in hybrid form: online, in Dachau, Germany, and in the partner countries, from 07/06/2021 to 14/06/2021.

**Short description:** The event was organized in hybrid form, because of the Covid-19 pandemic. Citizens were involved in a workshop on comics and memory, with the aim to reflect on comics as a tool to deal with memories of WWII. The workshop included online session and in-person visits to national places of remembrance, including Dachau memorial, in Germany, as well as other memorial places, museums, and former concentration camp sites in the partner countries. On the last day of the workshop, the partners organized a public online discussion with the comic artist Aleksandar Zograf.

### **Event 5**

**Participation:** The event involved 30 citizens, including:

4 from Bosnia-Herzegovina,  
6 from Croatia,  
7 from Italy,  
5 from Slovenia,  
8 from Serbia.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Ljubljana, Slovenia, from 07/04/2022 to 10/04/2022.

**Short description:** the seminar in Ljubljana was organized with the aim to present the project and its methods to the target groups (teachers, educators, youth workers). During the event, the citizens exchanged good methods and practices, and visited locations connected to WWII. They developed methods together, to be used in their everyday work with young people.

## **Event 6**

**Participation:** The event involved 82 citizens, including:

1 from Bosnia-Herzegovina,

4 from Germany,

10 from Croatia,

64 from Italy,

2 from Slovenia,

1 from Spain.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Udine, Italy, from 25/05/2022 to 26/05/2022.

**Short description:** The final event included the dissemination of results, a guided tour in places connected to WWII in Udine, a public encounter with two survivors of Fascist concentration camps, and the opening of the exhibition "Qui si parla italiano, qui si saluta romanamente".
